# AS A TEACHER I CAN...

### **BE COLLABORATIVE**

There is a shared workload between the main classroom teachers on the year level. All teachers to equally participate in the filming of skill and concept lesson videos.



### **BE RESPECTFUL**

### **BE RESPONSIVE**

As a team, decide which key pieces of work will be marked each day. Each teacher will ensure that these key pieces are marked and written/ verbal/ video feedback is given in a timely manner (within the week).



### **BE CONNECTED**

Individual teachers are to ensure that their Class Dojo stories are up to date with communication and schedules of learning. Each year level is to produce an overview of learning each week as well as a daily schedule of learning.

Ensure regular communication with families - through a phone call/ Class Dojo/ email.



### **BE INVOLVED**

## Term Learning Overviews

### **FAITH BASED INQUIRY**

This term students will be further exploring:

- Forces push/pull, the force of gravity, air resistance, friction
- Catholic Social Teachings: "The Common Good"
  - Forgiveness
  - What is the best for everyone?





### **LITERACY**

This term students will be learning:

- Information Reports
- Facts/Opinions
- Summarising
- Procedure Text
- Grammar -verbs, adverbs, adjectives
- Punctuation capital letters, full stops, commas, exclamation marks

To help your child at home, you can:





- Read together as a family
- Ask your child questions about the book they're reading

### **MATH**

This term, students will be learning:

- Multiplicative Thinking arrays, repeated addition, times tables
- Division the relationship between division and multiplication
- Fractions identifying fractions, equivalency, ordering of, mixed numbers (improper fractions)
- Time hours, minutes, seconds, digital/analogue clocks, time intervals



To help your child at home, you can:

- Quiz your child on times tables
- Talk about division in daily tasks sharing of pizza slices, fruit, etc
- Talk about fractions in everyday life - when cutting fruit, measuring for cooking, etc
- Refer to watches/clocks when speaking about time in everyday life

# **SEL - SOCIAL EMOTIONAL LEARNING**

This term in SEL, students will focus on Respectful Relationships.
