### 2021 SACRAMENTAL AND NON-CATHOLIC SCHOOL RELIGIOUS EDUCATION ENROLMENTS (RES&STA)

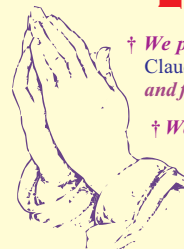
