To help your child at home, you could encourage them to:

- Practise counting backwards and forwards beginning from different numbers
- Play games that involve counting, adding and subtracting numbers such as 'Snakes and Ladders,' 'Bingo' or 'I Spy'
- Look at and say the numbers on car number plates, signs, calendars, newspapers, shopping catalogues etc.
- Use house hold objects to identify 3D shape and build constructions

This term in **Faith Based Inquiry** students will be exploring the big concept of

"Discovery God's Creatures and our Environment."

Students will explore; How do I show respect for Creation? The earth and all life on it are part of God's creation. We are called to respect this gift. We are responsible for taking care of the world we live in and for sharing all the wonders and resources the earth gives us.


