REMINDER

LITERACY

This term in Literacy, students will be exploring:

- Persuasive writing
- Letter writing
- Reading comprehension skills
- Blends and digraphs (letter combinations)
- How to use conjunctions in writing (for, and, nor, but, or, yet and so)

To help your child at home, you could encourage them to:

- Write letters, emails or cards to family and friends
- Use pictures to explain how a story character might be feeling and why
- Verbally list the important events and information found in their texts when reading
- Provide reasons for their decisions
- Explain why they enjoy doing one activity over another





NUMERACY

This term in Numeracy, students will be exploring:

- Fractions (halves ½, quarters
 ¼, and eighths ⅓)
- Location using maps to give simple directions and looking at the placement of objects in relation to others
- Addition and subtraction strategies





To help your child at home, you could encourage them to:

- Help you double or halve a recipe.
 Encourage your child to record new measurements for the recipe. Discuss why and when you might need to do this
- Cut their toast or sandwich into 2, 4, or 8 equal parts (with assistance)
- Describe how to get to familiar places when travelling in the car or walking
- Find objects around the house by following simple directions
- Continue counting in groups of:
 - o 2's (2, 4, 6, 8...)
 - o 5's (5, 10, 15, 20...)
 - o 10's (10, 20, 30, 40...)

FAITH BASED INQUIRY

This term, students will be learning about communities. Students will explore how they are connected to different communities, the St Anthony's church community, how the sacrament of Baptism helps people to grow in a faith community and the community of Noble Park.

Students will also explore strong women in the Bible and women who have empowered or are empowering people in their communities.

To help your child at home, you could:

- Talk to your child about female role models in your family
- Explore your community by talking about the places you visit or pass and their importance
- Show them pictures of their own Baptism and describe the event
