It is important that students are getting plenty of sleep each night. An example of a good bedtime for Year 1 and 2 students is 7.30 – 8.00pm.



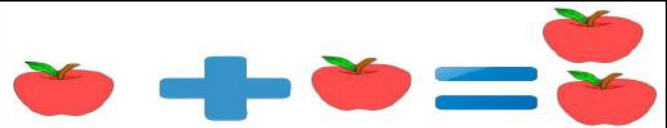
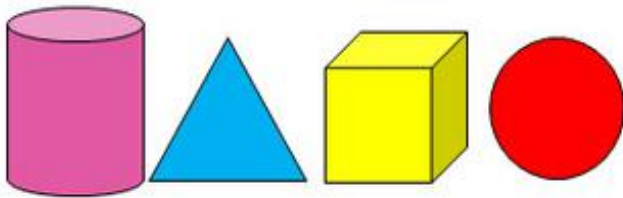
Due to the new Sun Smart Policy, all students will need to keep hats in their bags during Term 2.



NUMERACY

This term in Numeracy, students will be learning about:

- 2D and 3D shapes
- Data
- Patterns and Algebra
- Addition
- Subtraction
- Length



To help your child at home, you could encourage them to:

- Count in groups of:
 - 2s (2,4,6,8)
 - 5s (5,10,15,20)
 - 10s (10,20,30,40)
- Identify and describe 2D and 3D objects around the house
- Draw, create and make their own patterns
- Collect and count objects such as toys, shells and flowers
- Practise counting forwards and backwards to 120
- Practise adding number facts to 20 (11 + 9)

LITERACY

This term in Literacy, students will be learning about:

- Narratives
- Transactional Writing
- Poetry
- Reading Strategies



To help your child at home, you could encourage them to:

- Write letters or cards to family and friends
- Make up stories with a problem and solution
- Write out their own lunch orders
- Discuss the events that happen in the movies they watch
- Read together as a family
- Predict what is going to happen next in a story

INQUIRY

This term in Inquiry, students will continue to learn about Problem Solving through the areas of:



- Construction
- Communication
- Religion
- Literature and Science
- Different Cultures

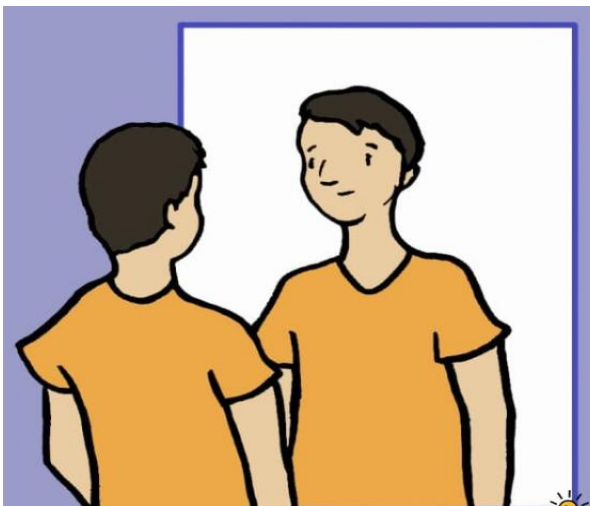


Students will design a solution to a problem, test their problem and make changes to improve their solutions

RELIGION

In Religion, students will cover the unit 'In God's Image'. During this unit, students will:

- Look at different images of God
- Understand how they are created in the image of God
- Interpret ways that images of God can be lived out in the community
- Reflect on scriptural images of God and identify those to which they have a connection



SEL

This term in Social and Emotional Learning, students will learn about 'Help Seeking'.



In this unit students will:

- Identify people they can go to for help at school, at home and in the community
- Learn about situations where they might need to ask for help
- Identify ways they can help other people
- Understand the emotions and feeling they may experience when they feel uncomfortable
- Learn about different ways to ask for help
